The Abingdon Arms

On the outside wall of the entrance porch to the pub.

Beside the playing field side entrance.

Neither cabinet is locked. When you open the cabinet door, this is what you will see:

The defibrillator

The defib should show a green indicator in the **Rescue Ready** status display



Even if the status display shows red there should be sufficient battery charge to give up to a further 8 shocks.

Remove the defibrillator from its storage hook. When you open the defibrillator using the catch at the bottom of the machine, this is what you will see:



If the battery is nearing full discharge the voice instructions will tell you whether or not the defibrillator can be used.

When you take the defibrillator to the emergency **DON'T FORGET TO TAKE THE READY KIT WITH YOU!**

- Pocket mask for optional use when giving breaths
- Strong scissors
- Razor
- Towel
- Gloves (for optional use)
